


Crawford County, PAFire

PA109 is located in Pleasantville, PA and provides gap-filling coverage for 60 miles in every direction. Orange circles represent NEXRAD systems out to 4,000ft above the ground. Blue circles represent radar "gaps" and planned or live supplemental Climavision radar sites – areas with diminished coverage beyond the low-level visibility of NEXRAD systems. The nearest NEXRAD radar to Erie is KBUF around 90 miles away.







April 23, 2025

Crawford County, PAFire

On April 23, 2025, a fire began in Crawford County, Pennsylvania. The area was experiencing an increased risk of wildfires due to dry conditions and a low amount of snowfall from the previous winter. It was unclear what began this fire and whether it was a brush or structure fire. Climavision's PA109 system detected the smoke plume, including the direction it was travelling. The nearby NEXRAD radar also detected the smoke plume.
